4. **Issue & Submission of Application Forms (Online only) :**

a) Date : 24.05.2017 (10.00 a.m.) to 09.06.2017 (1.30 p.m.)

Note: All the formalities including online payment to be completed within this period.

b) **Generation of Online Admit Card:**

Since our application process begins on 24.05.2017, students applying for admission test before the publication of WBCHSE, 2017, results, are asked to see the website for any change in Schedule after the publication of WBCHSE, 2017, results. In the event of any change of schedule, they must download the admit card once again for the re-scheduled dates.

c) The students will be required to upload **recent passport size photograph & Signature (JPEG format, <100 kb).**

d) **No Candidate will be allowed to take the admission test without production of the Admit Card and the online payment receipt.**

8. A) **Full Marks and duration of tests:**

- i) All subjects except English:
Full marks: 50; Duration of test: 1 hour 30 minutes
- ii) English:
Full marks: 50; Duration of test: 2 hours

B) Use of Calculator:

- 1) Calculator **is not allowed** for admission test for the subjects: Physics, Mathematics.
- 2) Calculator **is allowed** for admission test for the subjects: Chemistry, Statistics, Economics, and Computer Science.

9. **List for provisional selection will be prepared on the basis of :**

- A. **Physics** : Marks obtained in Admission Test out of 50 will be converted to marks out of 200 + Marks obtained in 10+2 Physics (100) + Marks obtained in 10+2 Mathematics (100) = Total 400
- B. **Chemistry** : Marks obtained in Admission Test out of 50 will be converted to marks out of 200 + Marks obtained in 10+2 Chemistry (100) + Marks obtained in 10+2 Physics (50) + Marks obtained in 10+2 Mathematics (50) = Total 400
- C. **Mathematics** : Marks obtained in Admission Test out of 50 will be converted to marks out of 200 + Marks obtained in 10+2 Mathematics (100) + Marks obtained in 10+2 Physics (50) + Marks obtained in 10+2 English (50)= Total 400
- D. **Statistics** : 80% weight on admission test + 20% weight on 10+2 Mathematics marks = Total 100
- E. **Computer Science** : Marks obtained in Admission Test (50) + Aggregate of the best 4 subjects in 10+2 (50) = Total 100
- F. **Economics** : Marks obtained in Admission Test (50) + Aggregate of the best 4 subjects in 10+2 (50) = Total 100
- G. **English** : 80% weight on admission test + 20% weight on 10+2 English = Total 100
- H. **History** : Marks obtained in Admission Test (50) = Total 50
- I. **Sanskrit** : Marks obtained in Admission Test (50) + Aggregate of the best 4 subjects in 10+2 (50) = Total 100

10. Scholarships are granted to a restricted number of **meritorious but financially weak students.**
