**w.e.f session 2011-2012 (Semester system)**

**Remarks:** Relevant changes and streamlining in the existing syllabus prescribed by the **University of Calcutta**.

- 1. “Aspects of Antiquity” –Paper-V (Honours) has been shifted to 1<sup>st</sup> year course and divided into 2 courses/papers: Paper-II and Paper-IV for Semester-I and Semester-II respectively.**
- 2. “History of India from C 600 to C 1500” –Paper-II (Honours) has been shifted from 1<sup>st</sup> year to 2<sup>nd</sup> year and divided into 2 papers: Paper-VI and Paper-VIII with following nomenclature respectively:**
  - **The Early Medieval India (from C 600 to C 1200)**
  - **The Crescent in India: History of India (from C 1200 to C 1500)**

**These papers will be taught in the Semester-III and Semester-IV respectively.**

- 3. “History of India from C1500 to C1800” – Paper-IV (Honours) has been shifted to 3<sup>rd</sup> year and divided into 2 papers (Paper-IX and Paper-XIII) respectively to be taught in Semester-V and Semester-VI. Names of the papers:**
  - **The Great Timurides: India from C1500 to C1707 (Paper-IX)**
  - **India in Transition: History of India from C 1707 to C 1800 (Paper-XIII)**
- 4. In all the newly designed papers (each of 50 marks) internal changes, additions, omissions have been made according to the decisions taken by and recommendations of the Board of Studies in its meetings exclusively held for this purpose on the following dates:**
